Wash hands with soap and water for 15 seconds, or use hand sanitizer



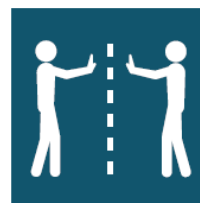
Cough or sneeze into your bent elbow or a tissue, then wash hands

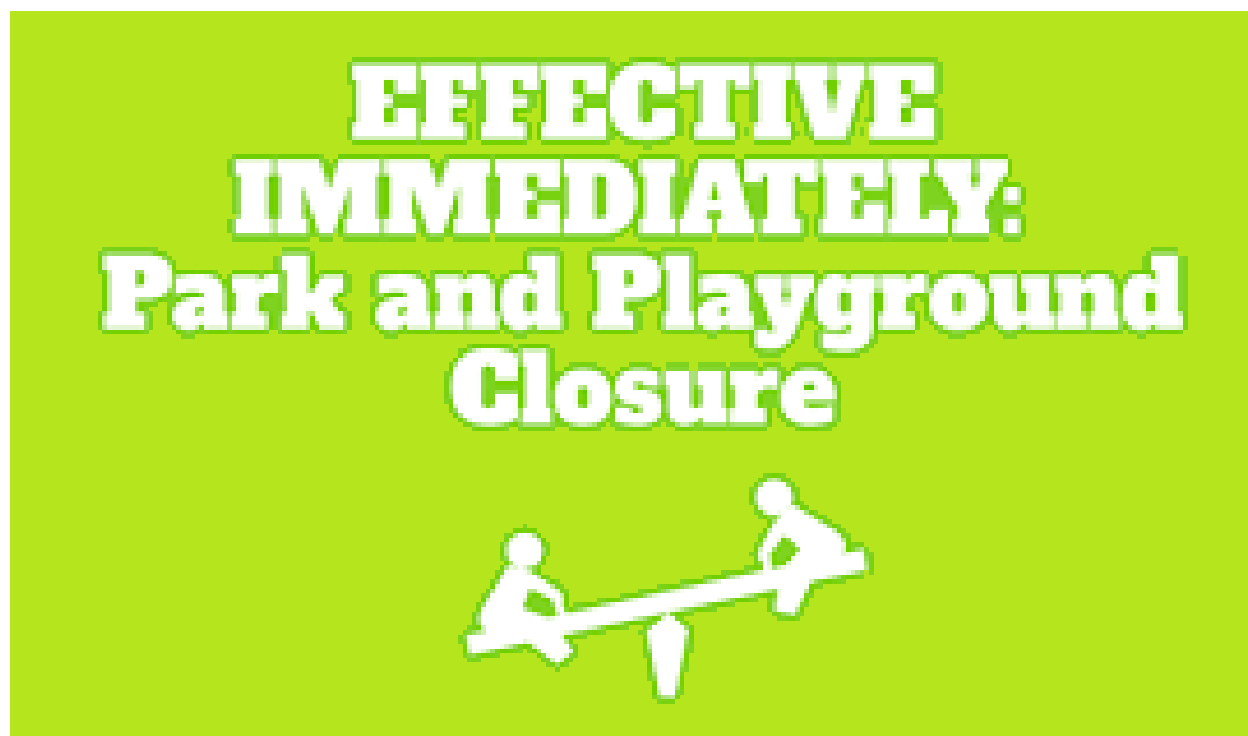
